## **Pre-Nursery Expectations**



Your child will be starting their education at Green Lane Primary Academy Nursery very soon and we would like to make sure your child is ready.

We understand that all children learn and develop at different rates, but below are simple expectations that each child who has not been identified as having special educational needs should have.

These expectations are appropriate for children aged three.

#### PHYSICAL DEVELOPMENT

- ♦ Toilet trained
- ♦ Able to turn pages in a book
- ♦ Make marks using a pencil
- ♦ Able to feed themselves and drink from a cup

#### LITERACY SKILLS

- ♦ Able to be understood when speaking
- ♦ Able to repeat words and sentences from stories
- ♦ Join in with and sing some nursery rhymes
- ♦ Able to talk about what they have drawn/seen



## MATHS SKILLS

- ♦ Able to say some number names in order
- ♦ Able to use words related to size such as big and small
- ♦ Able to give you 1,2 or 3 objects when asked
- ♦ Able to anticipate time based events such as lunch time and bed time

By ensuring that you have began developing these skills with your child before starting Nursery, you will be giving them a really strong start in their education.
